Three Palm Sunday Entries into Jerusalem

1. The Passover Entry:

The celebration of being set free from the Egyptian Empire.

Attendance at Passover was mandatory
(Lev. 23:4-8)

2. The Roman Entry:

Roman rulers were present to keep the peace.

The Roman Entry was a show of strength and dominance over the Jewish people.

3. The “Triumphant” Entry:

Jesus comes as a King of peace.

Jesus comes to Jerusalem to declare his kingship.
