<u>Cultural Beatitudes:</u> Blessed are the <u>rich</u> and <u>famous</u> Blessed are the <u>good-looking</u> Blessed are those who <u>party</u> Blessed are those who take <u>first place</u> Blessed are the <u>movers</u> and <u>shakers</u> Blessed are those who demand their <u>rights</u> Blessed are the <u>healthy</u> and <u>fit</u> Blessed are those who make it to the <u>top</u> The Beatitudes reveal:

- 1. <u>Supreme blessedness</u> comes <u>with</u> the Kingdom of God.
- 2. A <u>foretaste</u> of the Kingdom can be <u>experienced</u> right <u>now</u>.
