Important things to remember for seasons of waiting in faith:

1. Waiting in faith reveals God's power.

"9 But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me." ~2 Corinthians 12:9~

2. Waiting in faith strengthens our character.

"3 Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; 4 perseverance, character; and character, hope." ~Romans 5:3-4~

3. Waiting in faith <u>deepens</u> our <u>intimacy</u> and relationship with God.

"6 Sarah said, "God has brought me laughter, and everyone who hears about this will laugh with me." ~Genesis 21:6~
