Insights for Christian Suffering from Philippians 1:

1. Suffering is not glorious.

"I am in chains for Christ."

~Philippians 1:13b

2. Suffering is not meaningless.

"12 Now I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that what has happened to me has actually served to advance the gospel." ~Philippians 1:12

3. Suffering is not a cause for despair. Verse 18-19

"Yes, and I will continue to rejoice" ~Philippians 1:18b

4. Suffering <u>reveals</u> what is <u>important</u> .
