## How the followers of Jesus Responded to his Death:

- The women that were closest with Jesus went to the tomb to prepare his <u>dead</u> body.
- The disciples that were closest to Jesus <u>did not believe</u> that he could have risen from the dead.
- Other followers of Jesus had **lost hope** that this man they had been looking to was the messiah.

<sup>45</sup> Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures, <sup>46</sup> and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, <sup>47</sup> and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. <sup>48</sup> You are witnesses of these things.

## How the followers of Jesus live after they experience the resurrected Christ:

- With **hope**, **joy**, and **peace** that supersedes experiences.
- With the understanding they have been forgiven of sin and given **<u>new spiritual life</u>**.
- With the understanding that they have been given <u>eternal</u> <u>life</u> through Christ.
