Romans 9:1-3

Paul's explanation of Israel and God's Sovereignty:

- Not all of Israel was true Israel in the Old Testament (v.6-13).
 - "It is about grace, not race." ~N.T. Wright~
- God hardened Pharaoh's heart to accomplish his purposes (v.14-18).
- How God can be sovereign over all of creation and still hold people accountable for their actions (v. 19-29)

"Surely if he (God) would not spare or abate to his own son one stroke, one tear, one groan, one sigh, one circumstance of misery, it can never be imagined that he should, after this, deny his people, for whose sake all this was suffered, any mercies, any comforts, any privilege, spiritual or temporal, which is good for them..."
