

Live with a harvest REALITY.

The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.
Luke 10:2

- It includes a right **PERSPECTIVE**. “plentiful”
- It includes a heartbreaking **PROBLEM**. “few”
- It includes an essential **PLEA**. “ask”

Live with a harvest MENTALITY.

*When you enter a house, first say, ‘Peace to this house.’ If a **man of peace** is there, your peace will rest on them; if not, it will return to you. Stay in that house, eating and drinking whatever they give you, for the worker deserves his wages. Do not move around from house to house.*
Luke 10:5-7

- Know what to **LOOK** for: A **MAN** of **PEACE**.
Luke 10:6
- Know your **MESSAGE**:
“the Kingdom of God Is near you.” Luke 10:9, 11

Live with a harvest PRIORITY.

The seventy-two returned with joy and said, “Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name.” He replied, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.”

Luke 10:17-20

- Sometimes God does things that are **SPECTACULAR**.
- Sometimes God works through the **ORDINARY**.
- The important goal of the harvest is **GETTING IT IN!**
“but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.”
