Revelation 11 Douglas Translation

¹Then a measuring rod that resembled a shepherd's staff was given to me along with this declaration: "Get up and go measure God's temple and the altar. Also, take an estimate of those worshiping within it. ²Pay no attention to the outer courtyard of the temple! Do not take its measurement because it's been given to the nations, and they will trample the holy city for 42 months. ³Then I will appoint my two witnesses. They will proclaim God's word for 1,260 days, while wearing sackcloth." ⁴They are the two olive trees and two lampstands that stand before the Lord of the earth. ⁵If anyone desires to harm them, fire will go forth from their mouth and consume their enemies. Indeed, if someone wishes to harm them, it is necessary for them to be killed in this way. ⁶They have the authority to shut heaven so that it does not rain a drop during the days of their prophetic proclamation. They also have authority over the waters to turn them into blood and to smite the earth with any plague whenever they wish. ⁷When they've completed their testimony, the beast that rises from the abyss will make war with them. The beast will vanquish them and kill them. ⁸Their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city, which is referred to in a spiritual sense as Sodom and Egypt. This is also where they crucified their Lord. ⁹Then, some folks from the people groups, tribes, linguistic communities, and nations will gaze upon their dead bodies for three and a half days. They will refuse to allow their bodies to be placed in a grave. ¹⁰The ones who dwell upon the earth will rejoice with them, party, and send one another gifts because the two prophets greatly annoyed the ones dwelling upon the earth. ¹¹After the three and a half days, a breath of life from God entered into them, and they stood on their feet. Incredible fear fell upon those who saw them. ¹²The witnesses heard a booming voice from heaven, declaring to them, "Come up here!" Then, they ascended into heaven by cloud as their enemies watched them. ¹³At that very moment, an incredible earthquake occurred. A tenth of the city fell and 7,000 well-known people were killed by the earthquake. Those who remained became terrified and gave glory to the God of heaven. ¹⁴The second woe is past. Behold! The third woe is coming soon.
