## Romans 10:8-15 HCSB

<sup>8</sup>On the contrary, what does it say? The message is near you, in your mouth and in your heart. This is the message of faith that we proclaim: <sup>9</sup>If you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup>One believes with the heart, resulting in righteousness, and one confesses with the mouth, resulting in salvation. <sup>11</sup>Now the Scripture says, Everyone who believes on Him will not be put to shame, <sup>12</sup>for there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, since the same Lord of all is rich to all who call on Him. <sup>13</sup>For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

<sup>14</sup>But how can they call on Him they have not believed in? And how can they believe without hearing about Him? And how can they hear without a preacher? <sup>15</sup>And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: How beautiful are the feet of those who announce the gospel of good things!
