Reflection

I love how Paul wraps up this discussion. In a very real way he proves that making the end times a topic of conversation isn't a bad thing. I know this because he actually encourages his fellow Jesus-followers to talk about it.

But ...

His words also reveal that we ought to talk about the end times in a very specific way. Paul doesn't want us to argue or put each other down as we talk about the end times. Rather, let our end times talk be about building up one another. Unfortunately, it's often the former posture rather than the latter that characterizes discussions about our King's return. But I pray that such would not be the case with you. May we always, even when discussing difficult and touchy subjects, be about speech that builds one another up.
