Missions Spotlight – GABON: Please pray for the following requests from Bongolo Hospital staff:

- The electrical system--the local power company has been having technical difficulties, causing it to be unable to provide consistent power to this entire region of Gabon. Because of this, the hospital has had to use the backup generator much more than usual, which costs a lot for fuel and wears down the generator.
- The water system--there have been some issues with our station/hospital?s water system which have caused us to have frequent water outages and low water pressure.
- Finances for the hospital--the Gabonese insurance company still hasn?t paid their bill, making it hard for us to be place medicine orders and cover salaries. Pray for God?s provision.
- Hospital leaders need wisdom and encouragement as they navigate these challenges.
- Teammates continue to have sick family members back in the United States.
