After Paul had seen the vision, we got ready at once to leave for Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them. Acts 16:10

For example, a woman named Lydia was already a worshiper of God when "the Lord opened her heart to respond to Paul's message" about Jesus. Even the resistance of a hardened jailer crumbled. Trembling before Paul and Silas, he asked, "What must I do to be saved?"
