Reflection

In the Gospel of John there's this short passage at the end of chapter 2 that has always intrigued me and ... given me pause. Here it is:

"23 While he was in Jerusalem during the Passover festival, several people came to trust in his name, because they had seen the signs he did. 24 But Jesus didn't entrust himself to them. He knew everything, 25 and had no need for anyone to give him information about people. He himself knew what was inside people." (NTE Translation)

Jesus knows what's inside you. This helps us see that He really is God. But I also hope it helps us see that if you're restless, He already knows it! So, why not run to Him and find that rest He already knows you need!
